

Community Engagement Champion

The role of a **Community Engagement Champion** involves assisting with the following activities, *usually* accompanied by a member of staff or an experienced volunteer.

Key tasks:

- Facilitate public participation in our interactive activities (eg smoothie bike, recycling and food waste games, upcycling and cookery demos)
- Support the delivery of events such as litter picks and workshops, where you would help sign up participants and give out resources
- Invite the public to feedback their responses to our events through online surveys and feedback forms
- Present materials attractively on a stall or in an event space, like our [Reuse Showhome](#)
- Give out information and bins, and/or survey people about their waste and recycling habits on their doorstep or in public places
- Distribute posters, fliers, stickers and painted stencils in shops, stairwells and streets
- Monitor and record the number and fullness of bins presented on recycling days
- Packing up kits of free resources to give out at events
- Helping construct upcycled props, such as recycling games, to use at events



Key skills:

- Friendly, personable manner
- Passion for the circular economy and helping people reduce waste
- Ability to use a tablet / ipad or willingness to learn
- Ability to convey information in a clear, accurate and positive way
- Ability to work positively as part of a team
- A good listener who can communicate effectively and tailor their engagement style and advice to different people

Where: Venues throughout Leith and Edinburgh

When: Weekdays and weekends, office hours and evenings

Time commitment: Flexible. Minimum 2 hours / month.
